<p><u>1. The infinitive</u></p> <p>An infinitive is a verb that in French ends in « -er », « -ir » or « -re ».</p> <p>For example: jouer = to play dormir = to sleep faire = to do.</p>	<p><u>2. pouvoir = to be able to (can)</u></p> <p>Je peux = I can Tu peux = You(s) can Il/elle/on peut = he/she/we(inf.) can Élodie peut = Élodie can Nous pouvons = we(form.) can Vous pouvez = you(p) can Ils/elles peuvent = they can</p>	<p><u>3. The future tense</u></p> <p>To form the future tense in French, you need aller in the present tense followed by the infinitive:</p> <table border="1" data-bbox="1093 292 2190 619"> <tr> <td data-bbox="1093 292 1659 619"> <p>aller = to go</p> <p>Je vais = I am going Tu vas = You(s) are going Il/elle/on va = he/she/we(inf.) is/are going Thomas va = Thomas is going Nous allons = we(form.) are going Vous allez = you(p) are going Ils/elles vont = they are going</p> </td> <td data-bbox="1659 292 2190 619"> <p>aller (in present tense) + infinitive</p> <p>Example : Je vais manger = I am going to eat Martine va manger = Martine is going to eat</p> </td> </tr> </table>		<p>aller = to go</p> <p>Je vais = I am going Tu vas = You(s) are going Il/elle/on va = he/she/we(inf.) is/are going Thomas va = Thomas is going Nous allons = we(form.) are going Vous allez = you(p) are going Ils/elles vont = they are going</p>	<p>aller (in present tense) + infinitive</p> <p>Example : Je vais manger = I am going to eat Martine va manger = Martine is going to eat</p>
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<p><u>4. Opinions and nouns</u></p> <p>In French, when talking about sports or musical instruments, you need to put the article after the opinion. But not in English!</p> <p>Example: I like football = j’aime le foot. I don’t like tennis = je n’aime pas le tennis. I like the guitar = J’aime la guitare.</p>	<p><u>5. Opinions and verbs</u></p> <p>In French, when giving your opinions about activities, you need to put the infinitives after the opinion.</p> <p>Example: I like to play football = j’aime jouer au foot. I like to go/do dancing = J’aime faire de la danse. I like to sleep = j’aime dormir.</p>	<p><u>6. Prepositions</u></p> <p>When talking about sports you play, you need to use “au” or “aux” after the verb when talking about sports but “du”, “de la”, “de l’”, “des” when talking about musical instruments.</p> <table border="1" data-bbox="1093 722 2190 938"> <tr> <td data-bbox="1093 722 1624 938"> <p>For example: I play (+ sports) = je joue à football = le foot. I play football = je joue au foot. cards = les cartes. I play cards = je joue aux cartes.</p> </td> <td data-bbox="1624 722 2190 938"> <p>For example : I play (+ musical instruments) = je joue de piano = le piano. I play the piano = je joue du piano. trumpet = la trompette I play the trumpet = je joue de la trompette.</p> </td> </tr> </table>		<p>For example: I play (+ sports) = je joue à football = le foot. I play football = je joue au foot. cards = les cartes. I play cards = je joue aux cartes.</p>	<p>For example : I play (+ musical instruments) = je joue de piano = le piano. I play the piano = je joue du piano. trumpet = la trompette I play the trumpet = je joue de la trompette.</p>
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<p><u>7. Did you know ?</u></p> <p>In France, there is no school on Wednesday afternoon. Students finish lessons at midday and then attend extra-curricular clubs either with their school or a club. The most popular sport is football followed by tennis, horse-riding, judo, basketball, handball, rugby and golf.</p>	<p><u>8.
