Woking High School Prom 2023

Dear Parents/Carers and Students,

We are writing to inform you of the details for the Woking High School Prom 2023. The event will take place at Chobham Golf Club on Thursday 29th June from 7.30pm -11pm. The cost of the ticket for the Prom is £35, with seats being reserved by making a payment online at www.scopay.com.

Prom is an excellent opportunity for students to celebrate their achievements, and for staff to say their 'goodbyes' and 'best wishes'. Attendance at the Prom, however, is subject to a student's behaviour, attendance and attitude. Please read the terms and conditions carefully; by paying for the ticket you are agreeing to the terms and conditions of attendance at the Prom.

Terms and Conditions:

- The payment of the ticket is indicating a student's intent to attend the Prom.
- This cost is non-refundable (all aspects and costing for the Prom are based on the number of students indicating their intent to attend).
- Students must attend all timetabled immersion sessions prior to their exams, unless absent due to illness as reported by the parent/carer and supported by medical evidence where the absence is longer term.
- Students must sit all their GCSE exams and arrive on time for these, unless there are extenuating circumstances as communicated to school by the parent/carer.
- Attendance must be above 90% from week commencing 6th February 2023.
- Behaviour and attitude will be taken into consideration upon final payment. Poor behaviour and/or unacceptable attitude from any Year 11 student may result in them being prevented from attending the Prom. This includes any suspension dated from 6th February 2023.

We reserve the right to cancel tickets and refuse entry if students are deemed unsuitable for entry or participation on the evening.

The decision as to whether a student may not attend Prom is at the Headteacher's discretion.
